LOCAL FISHING REPORT



GERALDTON REGION

28th February 2017

OFFSHORE

Mackerel and tuna catches have been patchy with a few spanish mackerel to 11kg along with bonito and yellowfin tuna being picked up along the back of Pensioner's and north towards Coronation.

Pink snapper to 7kg, baldchin groper and dhufish around the 8kg mark have been reported out towards Mid Reef.

Working the coral patches out near the 40 metre mark has resulted in some good hauls of baldchin groper, pink snapper, red-throat emperor and dhufish to 7kg.

LANDBASED

A number of large mulloway have been getting around in the past week with anglers reporting some impressive captures from both north and south of town.

The stretch between Southgate's and Tarcoola Beach has produced a few mulloway with reports of fish up to 11kg, whilst Buller River and Oakagee has seen some large specimens to 15kg.

Chopper tailor can be found along the break walls and Seal Rocks although sizes are generally small however better fish up to 60cm can be found around the reef breaks of Point Moore, Explosives and Drummond's Cove.

Whiting can be found along Page's Beach through to Point Moore and north of town towards Buller River with early mornings producing the best results.

Anglers fishing around the Fisherman's Wharf have enjoyed good results on black bream to 34cm along with some thumping estuary cod to 72cm.

The Greenough River has seen plenty of activity after it's recent flushing with reports of small mulloway, yellowfin whiting, black bream along with a few mangrove jack to 50cm.
