LOCAL FISHING REPORT



GERALDTON REGION

26th July 2017

OFFSHORE

Vessels heading across to the Abrolhos Islands have reported some fine captures recently with the Hummock and surrounding areas proving to be a happy hunting ground. Coral trout in good numbers, baldchin groper to 50cm, pink snapper, spangled emperor up to 65cm and dhufish to 9kg have made up the bulk of catches.

South West Bank continues to produce quality fish with dhufish to 12kg, pink snapper up to 75cm, red throat emperor and a few nice baldchin groper.

West of town fishing the 30 – 40 metre mark has resulted in mixed bags of baldchin groper, pink snapper, dhufish and red throat emperor.

Squid are still around in good numbers with the usual haunts of Page's, Explosive's and Point Moore providing inshore fisho's with with a tasty meal.

LAND BASED

Tailor catches seem to be on the rise after a relatively quiet winter with a few catches reported south of town. Lucy's Beach has been enjoying a nice run of choppers up to 40cm recently along with the occasional mulloway to 10kg.

Westbank is another location worth some time and effort with mulloway in the 10 -12kg range being reported. Drummond's cove and the beaches to the north are fishing well for a few nice tailor and mulloway around the 8kg mark.

Around town Pages Beach, Explosives and Point Moore have been producing some nice bags of yellowfin whiting with best results coming early morning or late afternoon, whilst Separation Point has produced the goods with tailor up to 70cm hitting surface lures around the reef breaks.
