LOCAL FISHING REPORT



GERALDTON REGION

8th August 2017

OFFSHORE

The Abrolhos Islands have been producing some nice captures recently particularly around the Southern Group. Large pink snapper to 10kg, dhufish, baldchin groper and coral trout have seen most anglers coming away with a nice feed.

Mid-Reef has been consistent with some quality pink snapper, baldchin groper, dhufish and occasional cobia being reported from this area.

Closer to home those fishing the 5 mile mark have enjoyed success on a number of species including dhufish to 9kg, spangled emperor, red-throat emperor, estuary cod and pink snapper. South of town African Reef is producing mixed bags of pink snapper to 70cm, dhufish, baldchin groper and breaksea cod

LANDBASED

Tailor catches have been steady throughout the mid-west with most of the larger specimens coming from reef breaks. Glenfield, Separation Point and Explosives reef have all produced their share of quality tailor with some solid fish up to 70cm being reported, whilst beaches such as Southgate's, Tarcoola and Westbank have enjoyed runs of fish in the 35 – 45cm range.

Seal Rock's has produced some nice captures of skippy or silver trevally with some specimens up to 1 kilo being reported in recent times

Catches of whiting have been strong with most gutters along the beaches holding good numbers of fish. Pages Beach, Tarcoola Beach, Southgates, Drummond's Cove and Coronation Beach are all worth a go

Mulloway catches have picked up with the full moon period often providing the best opportunity for anglers to tangle with this highly sought species. North of Coronation Beach, Southgate's Beach and Westbank are all popular locations with a 12kg fish reported from north of town earlier this week.
